Kick-Off the Visalia Senior Games with fun and excitement at our Opening Ceremony!

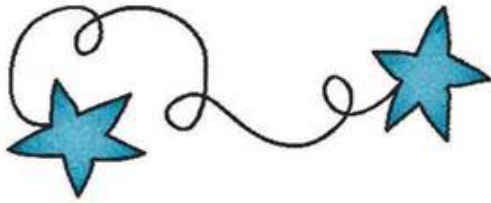
